1. Organizational Updates

- The Board was informed that Nevada Outdoor Recovery's 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status has been approved.
- The organization's Unique Entity ID (UEI) registration has been completed and is currently pending final activation through SAM.gov.
- The organization has applied for a Nevada Religious, Charitable, or Educational Sales Tax Exemption. Application status remains pending. (Denied needs to be operating for 12 months)
- D&B Business Credit Monitoring has been completed.

2. Website and Program Development

• Discussion was held regarding the development of the Nevada Outdoor Academy, a proposed public outdoor education program focused on:

- Leave No Trace Principles
- Wilderness First Aid Education
- Outdoor Safety Training
- Environmental Stewardship

3. Grants, Sponsorships, and Funding Opportunities

Donation and Sponsorship Updates: • Patagonia donated outdoor items to support organizational programming. • Scheels reviewed the organization's funding request but indicated applications must be submitted approximately six months in advance. A request was submitted for Nevada Free Fishing Day 2027. • REMSA Health was contacted regarding First Aid support and materials. Request remains pending. • Chipotle approved an in-kind donation consisting of two entrée certificates and one bag of chips and queso for fundraising and raffle purposes.

4. Community Partnerships

The Board reviewed current community partnerships, including:

Partnership opportunities and future collaboration efforts were discussed.

5. Community Events

- The M25 "Let's Go Fishing" Event held on June 20, 2026, was discussed.

Event support included: • Breakfast and refreshments for participants. • Doughboy's Donuts committed to providing one dozen. 4 clients were present and 1 was offered peer support services. Overall it was a great turnout.

6. Fundraising Discussion

The organization has received multiple new in-kind donated items.

The Board discussed the possibility of organizing a raffle-based fundraising event to:

- Increase community engagement.
- Raise unrestricted funds.
- Promote organizational visibility and outreach efforts.

Further planning and compliance requirements will be reviewed before implementation.
